_____It has been explained to me, that I fully understand, that occasionally there are complications with this treatment such as acne, breast enlargement, mood swings, as well as the following.

Extra fluid in the body- This can cause problems for patients with heart, kidney, or liver disease.
Sleep disturbance – This is called sleep apnea and is more likely to occur with patients who have lung disease or overweight.

Prostate enlargement – This may cause problems with urinating.

____Changes in cholesterol levels, red blood cell levels, PSA levels, liver function enzymes, and other hormone levels which will be monitored with periodic blood tests.

____I understand that I will have periodic blood tests to monitor my blood levels.

____I understand there is no guarantee as to the result and that if I stop treatment, my condition may return or get worse.

_____I have had the opportunity to discuss with Helix Health and its medical practitioners my complete past medical and health history including any serious problems and/or injuries. All of my questions concerning the risks, benefits, and alternatives have been answered. I am satisfied with the answers.

____I understand that the physical exam by Helix Health does not replace a full physical exam by a personal physician.

____ I agree to have my personal physician perform a yearly full physical exam including a digital rectal exam, lipid profile, cholesterol levels, and a comprehensive metabolic panel. If I do not have a personal physician, Helix Health will assist in locating one for me.

_____Testosterone cypionate/propionate, just like any medication carries risks, as well as benefits. And the risks include, but are not limited to: blood clots, stroke, heart attack. The FDA has approved testosterone replacement based on its benefit to risk ratio. Helix Health treats low testosterone in an appropriate and safe manner under a physician's supervision and only to patients for who it is deemed necessary.
